

# Ordinance No. 1004

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate easements for off-street parking and sidewalk across two lots located on the south side of Green Street between South Lee Street and South Fairfax Street in the city of Alexandria, Virginia.**

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings, and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for appointment of viewers was posted at the courthouse of the Corporation Court of Alexandria, Virginia, and two other public places in the City in the manner required by law, and

WHEREAS, viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and made their report, and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the report of said viewers recommending such vacation and of other evidence relative thereto, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the easements above mentioned and hereinafter described are not needed for public use, and it is in the public interest to vacate same.

## THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That an easement for off-street parking and sidewalk running across the west two feet of a lot located on the south side of Green Street between South Fairfax Street and South Lee Street in the City of Alexandria, which lot is known as lot 12, Block 8, Yates Garden Subdivision, be and hereby is vacated and abandoned.

Section 2. That an easement for off-street parking and sidewalk running across the east three feet of a lot located at the corner of Green Street and South Lee Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, which lot is known as lot 22, Block 8, Yates Garden Subdivision, be and hereby is vacated and abandoned.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
