

Ordinance No. 1111

AN ORDINANCE to vacate an unnamed 50 foot street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, located in the vicinity of Taylor Run Parkway, West and West End Subdivision.

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has approved the vacation of the hereinafter described unnamed street, and

WHEREAS, the viewers appointed by the City Council have recommended the vacation of the hereinafter described unnamed street.

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law for such vacations have been followed, and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that the hereinafter described unnamed street in the City of Alexandria, is no longer required for public use and it is in the best interest to abandon it, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described street, one of the public streets of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be, and the same hereby is, vacated and abandoned:

All of that street beginning at a corner of Lot 505 of the resubdivision of Lots 3 thru 16, West End, in the line of Chauncey Estate (now or formerly) and at the southwesterly corner of the 50 ft. street and running thence with the line of said estate (now or formerly) N 14° 15' E 50 feet to a corner of Lot 506; thence with the line of said lot S 75° 45' E 116.88 feet to the corner and in the westerly line of Taylor Run Parkway West; thence across the end of said 50 foot street and the westerly line of said Parkway S 14° 15' W 50 feet to a corner of Lot 505; thence with the line of said lot N 75° 45' W 116.88 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This Ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
