

Ordinance No. 1112

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 32A-5 of Chapter 32A of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Section 32A-5 relates to MAJOR AND MINOR TREES PERMITTED IN ALEXANDRIA, and which Chapter 32A relates to TREES, SHRUBS, PLANTS, AND VEGETATION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 32A-5, Chapter 32A of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Section 32A-5. Permitted Trees.

No permit shall be issued for and it shall be unlawful to plant in any place designated in section 32A-2 of this chapter any tree, shrub, plant or vegetation except only the following:

Shrubs and other vegetation

Any shrub under thirty inches in height

Standard lawn or park grass

No permit shall be issued for and it shall be unlawful to plant a tree in any place designated in section 32A-2 of this chapter unless there is at least one foot of unobstructed earth extending from the tree trunk on all sides.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This Ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
