

Ordinance No. 1115

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the last paragraph, Section 28-31, Article II, Chapter 28 of The City Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Chapter 28 relates to STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, which Article II relates to PARADES, which Section 28-31 relates to PARADE FEES, and which last paragraph relates to WAIVER OF FEES;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 28-31, Article II, Chapter 28 of The City Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953 as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

The permit fee and the cost for off-duty policemen may be waived by the City Council.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This Ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
