

Ordinance No. 1118

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend Subsection 37, Subsection (a), Section 35-16, Article III, Chapter 35 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Chapter 35 relates to ZONING, which Article III relates to USE, AREA AND REGULATIONS GENERALLY, which Section 35-16 relates to C-2 COMMERCIAL ZONE, which Subsection (a) relates to USES PERMITTED and which Subsection 37 relates to PROCESSING, DEVELOPING, PRODUCTION AND MANUFACTURE OF PHOTOGRAPH PRINTS.

WHEREAS, on April 11, 1961, Ordinance numbered 1116 relating to the same subject matter was passed by the Council, but inadvertently included in said Ordinance was a provision requiring a special use; and

WHEREAS, it was never the intention of the City Council to require a special use permit in said Ordinance which was initiated by the City Council on its own motion, and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to confirm its action in passing Ordinance numbered 1116 but with the erroneous provision requiring a special use permit deleted therefrom; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Subsection 37, Subsection (a), Section 35-16, Article III, Chapter 35 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

(37) Processing, developing, assembling and manufacture or production of photograph prints, provided there is no noxious or offensive odor, smoke, dust, gas, or noise.

Section 2. That in the opinion of the City Council an emergency exists and this is declared an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE because if the zoning law is not immediately changed to allow the above mentioned type of operation in business areas of the City, a large and desirable plant which would improve the general welfare in the City will be unable to locate in Alexandria.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall not be published but the Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This Ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
