

Ordinance No. 1208

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sections 1-15 and 1-16 and to amend subparagraph (c), and to amend and reordain subparagraphs (e), (g) and (h) of Section 1-20, all of Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended; which Section 1-15 relates to BOUNDARY OF THE SEVENTH WARD, which Section 1-16 relates to BOUNDARY OF THE EIGHTH WARD, which subparagraph (c) relates to the THIRD WARD AND ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES THEREIN, which subparagraph (e) relates to the FIFTH WARD AND ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES THEREIN, which subparagraph (g) relates to the SEVENTH WARD AND ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES THEREIN, which subparagraph (h) relates to the EIGHTH WARD AND ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES THEREIN, which Section 1-20 relates to ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES and which Chapter 1 relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 1-15, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Section 1-15. BOUNDARY OF THE SEVENTH WARD.

The boundary of the Seventh Ward shall be as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of South Quaker Lane with the centerline at Cameron Run on the south corporate limits, as established in 1951, and running thence with said south and west corporate limits in a generally westerly direction to the intersection of said limits with the centerline of Shirley Highway; thence northerly along the centerline of Shirley Highway to its intersection with the Arlington County line, lying just north of the centerline of King Sreet (Leesburg Turnpike); hence easterly along the Arlington County line to its intersection with the centerline of North Quaker Lane; thence southerly along the centerline of said Quaker Lane to its intersection with the centerline of Duke Street; thence easterly along said centerline of Duke Street to its intersection with the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence southerly along the centerline of said South Quaker Lane to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That Section 1-16, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Section 1-16. BOUNDARY OF THE EIGHTH WARD.

The boundary of the Eighth Ward shall be as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway on the southwesterly corporate limits, as established in 1951, running thence westerly and northerly on the southwesterly and westerly corporate limits of 1951, to the Arlington County line; thence easterly along the Arlington County line to its intersection with the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence following the centerline of the said Shirley Memorial Highway southerly to the point of beginning.

Section 3. That the last paragraph of subparagraph (c), Section 1-20, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

The Voting Place within the Powhatan Election District shall be at the Engine Company Number 4 Fire House, located at the intersection of Powhatan and Second Streets.

Section 4. That subparagraph (e), Section 1-20, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(e) Fifth Ward. Maury School Election District and Voting Place; Fairlington Election District and Voting Place; George Washington High School Election District and Voting Place; and Christian Fellowship Church Election District and Voting Place.

The Fifth Ward shall be divided into Maury School Election District, Fairlington Election District, George Washington High School Election District, and Christian Fellowship Church Election District.

The Maury School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of King Street and the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence northward along said right-of-way line to the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence westward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Alexandria Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of Timber Branch Parkway; thence southward on a line from the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of King Street, said line being perpendicular to King Street; thence eastward along the centerline of King Street to the point of beginning.

The Fairlington Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of King Street and Radford Street; thence northward along the centerline of Radford Street to the centerline of Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of Quaker Lane to the centerline of Crestwood Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Crestwood Drive to the centerline of Valley Drive; thence northward along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Wellington Road; thence northward along the centerline of Wellington Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Cameron Mills Road; thence southward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Alexandria Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of Timber Branch Parkway; thence southward along a line from the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of King Street, said line being perpendicular to King Street; thence westward along the centerline of King Street to the point of beginning.

The George Washington High School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Alexandria Avenue and Russell Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence southward along said right-of-way line to the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence westward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Russell Road; thence northward along the centerline of Russell Road to the point of beginning.

The Christian Fellowship Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Alexandria Avenue and Russell Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence northward along said right-of-way line to the centerline of Monroe Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway to the centerline of Bellefonte Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Bellefonte Avenue to the centerline of Russell Road; thence westward along the centerline of Lloyd's Lane to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Braddock Road to a point of beginning.

The Voting Place within the Maury School Election District shall be at the Maury School located at the west side of Russell Road between Rucker Place and Walnut Street.

The Voting Place within the Fairlington Election District shall be at the Blessed Sacrament School located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Kenwood Avenue and Braddock Road.

The Voting Place within the George Washington High School Election District shall be at the George Washington High School located at the east side of Mt. Vernon Avenue, between Glendale Avenue and Braddock Road.

The Voting Place within the Christian Fellowship Church Election District shall be at the Christian Fellowship Church located at 216-218 East Monroe Avenue.

Section 5. That subparagraph (g), Section 1-20, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(g) Seventh Ward. Minnie Howard School Election District and Voting Place; Patrick Henry School Election District and Voting Place; Duke Street Baptist Church Election District and Voting Place.

The Minnie Howard School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of intersections of North Quaker Lane and Seminary Road; thence northward along the centerline of Quaker Lane to the Arlington County line; thence westward along the

Arlington County line to the centerline of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence southward along the centerline of said highway to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the point of beginning.

The Patrick Henry School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the north boundary of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad right-of-way and Cameron Run on the southern City boundary; thence westward along said southern City boundary and northward along the western City boundary to the centerline of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the centerline of said highway to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the centerline of North Jordan Street; thence southward along the centerline of North and South Jordan Street to the centerline of Holmes Run; thence southward along the centerline of Holmes Run to the centerline of Cameron Run; thence southward along the centerline of Cameron Run to the point of beginning.

The Duke Street Baptist Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of South Quaker Lane and the southern boundary of the City; thence northward along the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the centerline of Duke Street; thence westward along the centerline of Duke Street to the centerline of North Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of North Quaker Lane to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence westward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the centerline of North Jordan Street; thence southward along the centerline of North and South Jordan Street to the centerline of Holmes Run; thence southward along the centerline of Holmes Run to the centerline of Cameron Run; thence southward along the centerline of Cameron Run to the southern boundary of the City; thence eastward along the southern boundary of the City to the point of beginning.

The Voting Place within the Minnie Howard School Election District shall be the Minnie Howard School located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Braddock Road and North Early Street.

The Voting Place within the Patrick Henry School Election District shall be at the Patrick Henry School located on the north side of Taney Avenue between Latham Street and Howard Street.

The Voting Place within the Duke Street Baptist Church Election District shall be the Duke Street Baptist Church located on the north side of Duke Street between Jordan Street and Gordon Street.

Section 6. That subparagraph (h), Section 1-20, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(h) Eighth Ward. St. James Methodist Church Election District and Voting Place; William Ramsay School Election District and Voting Place.

The St. James Methodist Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway and Seminary Road; thence northward along the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway to the Arlington County line; thence westerly along the Arlington County line to the western boundary of the city; thence southward along the western boundary of the City to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the point of beginning.

The William Ramsay School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway with the western boundary of the City; thence northward along the western boundary of the City to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence southward along the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway to the point of beginning.

The Voting Place within the St. James Methodist Church Voting District shall be the St. James Methodist Church located at 5000 Echols Avenue.

The Voting Place within the William Ramsay School Election District shall be at the William Ramsay School located at 5700 Sanger Avenue.

Section 7. That upon the passage of this ordinance the Director of the Department of General Services shall cause copies of this ordinance to be posted at the front door of the Court House, and at each voting place in each election district affected, for a period of at least thirty (30) days prior to the next election.

Section 8. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
