

# Ordinance No. 1308

**AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 25-10 and Section 25-11, Article I, Chapter 25 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 25 relates to PLUMBING AND GAS FITTING, which Article I relates to IN GENERAL, which Section 25-10 relates to REEXAMINATION, and which Section 25-11 relates to FEES FOR EXAMINATIONS AND REEXAMINATIONS.**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 25-10, Article I, Chapter 25 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 25-10. Reexamination.

In instances where an applicant fails an examination or reexamination he shall be ineligible for any subsequent reexamination for the following time periods:

- (a) After first examination ..... 1 month.
- (b) After first reexamination ..... 3 months.
- (c) After second reexamination and  
all subsequent reexaminations ..... 6 months.

Section 2. That Section 25-11, Article I, Chapter 25 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 25-11. Fees for examinations and reexaminations.

The fee for each examination and for each reexamination of master plumbers shall be ten dollars. The fee for each examination and for each reexamination of master gas fitters shall be five dollars. The fee for the examination of journeymen plumbers shall be two dollars and fifty cents. The fee for the examination of journeymen gas fitters shall be two dollars and fifty cents. No fees are required for the reexamination of journeymen plumbers or journeymen gas fitters. Required fees shall accompany applications.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
