

# Ordinance No. 1310

**AN ORDINANCE to amend Chapter 36 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new article numbered VII and a new article numbered VIII; which Chapter 36 relates to TAXATION, which new Article VII relates to and provides for a FEE FOR PROCESSING VACATION OF PUBLIC RIGHTS REQUESTS, and which new Article VIII relates to and provides for a FEE FOR PROCESSING EN-CROACHMENT REQUESTS.**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Chapter 36 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new article numbered VII to read as follows:

## ARTICLE VII. FEE FOR PROCESSING VACATION OF PUBLIC RIGHTS REQUESTS.

Sec. 36-45. Fee.

A fee of thirty-five dollars shall be charged to process each request to vacate a public right, including but not limited to rights in streets, sewers and public places.

Sec. 36-46. Fee prerequisite to hearing by planning commission and council.

No request for vacation shall be docketed for hearing before the planning commission or the city council without the payment of the fee required by section 36-45.

Section 2. That Chapter 36 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new article numbered VIII to read as follows:

## ARTICLE VIII. FEE FOR PROCESSING ENCROACHMENT REQUESTS.

Sec. 36-47. Fee.

A fee of thirty-five dollars shall be charged to process each request to be allowed to encroach upon any public way or right, including but not limited to streets, alleys, sidewalks and public places.

Sec. 36-48. Fee prerequisite to hearing by planning commission and council.

No request for encroachment shall be docketed for hearing before the planning commission or the city council without the payment of the fee required by section 36-47.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
