

# Ordinance No. 1316

## AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LOCAL ENROLLMENT AND PLACEMENT OF PUPILS IN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the School Board of the City of Alexandria at a meeting on Wednesday, April 7, 1965, recommended the adoption of an ordinance providing for the local enrollment or placement of pupils in the City of Alexandria public school system; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City of Alexandria, Virginia, hereby elects to be bound by the provisions of Article 1.2, Chapter 12 of Title 22 of the 1950 Code of Virginia as amended.

Section 2. That an emergency exists and this is declared an emergency ordinance for the reason that the City of Alexandria will lose a sizable amount of Federal funds if this ordinance is not enacted at once.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall not be published and shall become effective on and after April 7, 1965. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of public hearing and second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting.
