

Ordinance No. 1412

AN ORDINANCE granting a lease to The Little Theatre, its successors and assigns to use property located near the intersection of Wolfe and South Saint Asaph Streets in the City of Alexandria, Virginia for the purposes of a Little Theater.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of ordinance No. 1404, adopted September 27, 1966, and after due advertisement of the same once a week for four successive weeks in the Alexandria Gazette, a newspaper published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, bids in writing were received by the Mayor of said city until 7:30 o'clock P.M. November 8, 1966, for a lease authorizing the use of land, near the intersection of Wolfe and South Saint Asaph Streets in said city for Little Theater purposes; and

WHEREAS, at the open session of the City Council to receive bids, the Mayor read aloud the bids received and inquiry was made if there were any further bids to be offered; and

WHEREAS, there were no further bids offered, and the Mayor thereupon declared the bidding closed; and

WHEREAS, the bid of The Little Theatre is the highest and best bid in the interest of the City and the Council favors accepting that bid; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the right to lease certain City property located near the intersection of Wolfe and South Saint Asaph Streets in the City of Alexandria, for Little Theater purposes be, and the same hereby is granted The Little Theatre subject to the terms, conditions and provisions of ordinance No. 1404, this ordinance and an appropriate lease.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
