

Ordinance No. 1416

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 22-10, Article I of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Section 22-10 relates to VEHICLES CARRYING CHILDREN TO AND FROM PRIVATE SCHOOLS, KINDERGARTENS, ETC.—DISPLAY OF INFORMATION, which Article I relates to IN GENERAL, and which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 22-10, Article I of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a paragraph to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle having a seating capacity of more than fifteen persons to be operated in this city if it be yellow in color, unless such motor vehicle is regularly used for the purposes stated above. This section shall not apply to any motor vehicle used to transport passengers for hire, or for a fare operated daily on a regular schedule and maintaining its terminal in a city or town of this state.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
