

Ordinance No. 1420

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the last paragraph of Section 22-68, Article III, Division 2 of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which last paragraph relates to PENALTIES, which Section 22-68 relates to SAME—PENALTY, which Article III relates to OPERATION OF VEHICLES, which Division 2 relates to RECKLESS DRIVING, SPEEDING, ETC., and which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the last paragraph of Section 22-68, Article III, Division 2 of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

When any person shall be convicted of reckless driving for violation of subsection (i) of section 22-66 of this Code, then in addition to any other penalties provided by law, except in those cases for which revocation of licenses is provided in section 46.1-417 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, the operator's or chauffeur's license of such person shall be suspended by the court or judge for a period of not less than sixty days nor more than six months. In case of conviction the court or judge shall order the surrender of the license to the court where it shall be disposed of in accordance with the provisions of section 46.1-425 of the Code of Virginia, as amended. When the conviction is a second conviction which would require revocation under the provisions of section 46.1-417 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, the court shall suspend the operator's or chauffeur's license of such person and thereupon transmit the same to the division of motor vehicles. If such person so convicted has not obtained a license required by the aforementioned chapter 5 or is a nonresident, such court may direct in the judgment of conviction that for such period of not less than ten days nor more than six months, as may be prescribed in the judgment, such person shall not drive or operate any motor vehicles in this state.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
