

N ORDINANCE to amend Article VII of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new section numbered 22-184.1; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article VII relates to LIGHTING EQUIPMENT, and which new section numbered 22-184.1 relates to SIGNAL LIGHTS AT TRAFFIC HAZARDS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article VII of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section numbered 22-184.1 to read as follows:

ec. 22-184.1. Signal lights at traffic hazards.

Motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers, when temporarily stopped on the traveled or paved portion of the street so as to create a traffic hazard shall use all four turn signals simultaneously to signal approaching motorists of the existing hazard whenever such vehicle is equipped with a device which will cause the four turn signals to flash simultaneously. All four signals may be flashed simultaneously on vehicle stopped at the scene of a traffic hazard, but in no event shall all four signals be flashed simultaneously while the vehicle is in motion.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
