

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the first sentence of Section 22-94, Division 4, Article III, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article III relates to OPERATION OF VEHICLES, which Division 4 relates to DRIVING AUTOMOBILE, ENGINE, ETC., WHILE UNDER INFLUENCE OF INTOXICANTS OR NARCOTICS, which Section 22-94 relates to PENALTY; SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE and which first sentence relates to VIOLATION OF SECTION 22-93 and PENALTIES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the first sentence of Section 22-94, Division 4, Article III, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963; as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Any person violating any provision of * section 22-93 of this Code shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than two hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars or by confinement in jail for not less than one month nor more than six months, either or both in the discretion of the jury or the court trying the case without a jury.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
