

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend Section 42-3, Article II, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, which said Section 42-3 relates to ZONE BOUNDARIES: ADOPTION OF ZONING MAPS, which said Article II relates to ZONES AND GENERAL PROVISIONS, and which said Chapter 42 relates to ZONING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and by mailing, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the "FIFTH REVISED ZONING MAP" described and referred to in Section 42-3, Article II, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended in the particulars following so that the pieces of property hereinafter listed are changed to the respective zones specified:

All of Lots 4 and 5, Block 9, City of Alexandria Assessment Map 215, 1963 Edition, located at 226 and 228 West Glebe Road, having frontage on West Glebe Road of approximately 115 feet and containing approximately 0.3 acres.

FROM: RA, Residential
TO: C-O, Commercial Office

Section 2. That in the opinion of City Council an emergency exists and this ordinance is hereby declared an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE in order to provide prompt relief to a flood victim.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
