

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Section 11-2, and to amend and reordain Section 11-2, both of Chapter 11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 11 relates to ETHICS, which Section 11-2 relates to PARTICIPATION IN VOTE ON CERTAIN PROCEEDINGS PROHIBITED, and which Section 11-8 formerly related to CONTRACTS WITH AND SALE OF GOODS AND MATERIALS TO CITY and which now relates to SALE OF GOODS AND MATERIALS TO CITY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 11-2 of Chapter 11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 2. That Section 11-8 of Chapter 11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 11-8. * Sale of goods and materials to city.

* No paid or salaried city council appointee shall sell goods or materials to the city. The prohibition of this section shall not apply to nonsalaried members of boards and commissions, with respect to * goods and materials, provided they do not participate in the negotiation for or recommend such * goods or materials while acting in their capacity as a city council appointee.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
