

ORDINANCE NO. 1808

AN ORDINANCE to vacate that part of Princess Street extending eastward from North Union Street to the Potomac River in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings; and

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law, including the posting of notice to the land proprietors affected, have been followed; and

WHEREAS, viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and have made their report; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the report of the said viewers recommending the said vacation, and of other evidence relative thereto, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the portion of Princess Street hereinabove mentioned and herein-after described is not needed for public use and that it is in the public interest to vacate the said portion of Princess Street; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the part of Princess Street which extends eastward from North Union Street to the Potomac River in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and which is more particularly described as follows, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the east line of Union Street with the south line of Princess Street; thence with the east line of Union Street N. 9° 30' E. 66.08 ft. to the north line of Princess Street; thence with the north line of Princess Street S. 81° 10' E. 357.84 ft. to the bulkhead line (as established by the Corps of Engineers for the Potomac River Harbor); thence with said bulkhead line S. 8° 33' 27" W. 66.08 ft. to the south line of Princess Street; thence with the south line of Princess Street N. 81° 10' W. 358.92 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 23,679 sq. ft.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
