

AN ORDINANCE to amend Article II, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new Division numbered 3; which Chapter 2 relates to ADMINISTRATION, which Article II relates to OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES GENERALLY and which new Division 3 relates to BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, COMMITTEES, AUTHORITIES AND SIMILAR BODIES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article II, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new Division numbered 3 to read as follows:

DIVISION 3. BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, COMMITTEES,
AUTHORITIES AND SIMILAR BODIES.

Sec. 2-47.1. Term of office of council appointees when appointment is made for indefinite term.

Whenever the city council has heretofore made or hereafter makes an appointment or reappointment of any person to any board, commission, committee, authority or similar body and neither the law governing the appointment nor the council specifies any term of office for the person appointed, then the appointment shall be deemed to be made for a term of two years beginning on the date of appointment.

In those instances in which appointments are deemed to be for two-year terms by virtue of appointments heretofore made and the term has expired on or before October 10, 1972, appointees may continue to serve until they are reappointed or their successors are appointed. With respect to any such expired terms, the council shall meet from time to time within the next ninety days to consider appointments.

The provisions of this section shall not apply to persons appointed to any board, commission, committee, authority or similar body which is discharged.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
