

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sections 41-21 and 41-22 of Article III, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 41 relates to WEAPONS, which Article III relates to AIR GUNS, which Section 41-21 formerly related to SALE, ETC., TO PERSON UNDER SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE--PROHIBITED and now relates to PERSONS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE, and which Section 41-22 relates to SAME--FALSE STATEMENT OF AGE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 41-21 of Article III, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 41-21. Sale, etc., to person under eighteen years of of age--Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, lend, rent or otherwise transfer an air gun or projectiles therefor to any person whom he knows or has reasonable cause to believe is under eighteen years of age.

Section 2. That Section 41-22 of Article III, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 41-22. Same--False statement of age.

It shall be unlawful for any person falsely to represent himself to be eighteen years of age or over in order to obtain an air gun.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
