

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend Section 42-3, Article II, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which said Section 42-3 relates to ZONE BOUNDARIES; ADOPTION OF ZONING MAPS, which said Article II relates to ZONES AND GENERAL PROVISIONS, and which said Chapter 42 relates to ZONING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, by mailing and by posting, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the "FIFTH REVISED ZONING MAP" described and referred to in Section 42-3, Article II, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended in the particulars following so that the piece of property hereinafter listed is changed to the zone specified:

The northern 209 feet of Parcel 3541-03-01, City of Alexandria Assessment Map 52, 1963 Edition, containing 1.396 acres (60,800 sq. ft.) which parcel 3541-03-01 has frontage on South Pickett Street of approximately 1,000 feet.

FROM: RA Residence
TO: I-1 Light Industrial

Section 2. That in the opinion of the City Council an emergency exists and this is declared an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE; otherwise, due to a technicality in zoning law, development beneficial to the city will be lost.

Section 3. Copies of any matter incorporated in this ordinance by reference, including but not limited to the "FIFTH REVISED ZONING MAP", as amended, and any other map referred to in this ordinance, may be examined in the City Hall of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, at the office of the Department of Planning and Regional Affairs, the office of the City Clerk and the entrance hall on Market Square.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
