

ORDINANCE NO. 1904

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sections 33-81 and 33-82 of Division 1, and Sections 33-91 and 33-93 of Division 2, all of Article V, Chapter 33 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 33 relates to STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, which Article V relates to EXCAVATIONS, which Division 1 relates to GENERALLY, which Division 2 relates to PERMITS, which Section 33-81, relates to FEES--RESTORATION WORK PERFORMED BY CITY, which Section 33-82 relates to SAME--RESTORATION WORK PERFORMED BY UTILITY COMPANIES, which Section 33-91 relates to FEES, SURCHARGES AND INSPECTION COSTS--PAYMENT REQUIRED, and which Section 33-93 relates to SAME--SURCHARGE FOR OPENINGS IN NEW STREETS, ETC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 33-81, Division 1, Article V of Chapter 33 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 33-81. Fees--Restoration work performed by city.

The fees for restoration work done by the city shall be as follows:

(a) Asphalt base or top. For each square yard or fraction thereof of asphalt base and asphalt top in accordance with the following table:

(Zero inches to, but not including six inches in depth).

The first five yards	\$19.00
The next five yards	7.50
The next five yards	7.00
The next ten yards	6.50
For all yards over 25 yards	6.00

(Six inches and over in depth)

The first five yards	\$20.00
The next five yards	8.50
The next five yards	8.00
The next ten yards	7.50
For all yards over 25 yards	7.00

(b) Finished concrete pavement, concrete base and asphalt top, soil concrete base and asphalt top, or cobblestone pavement. For each square yard or fraction thereof of finished concrete pavement, concrete base and asphalt top, soil cement base and asphalt top, or cobblestone pavement in accordance with the following table:

NUMBER OF SQUARE YARDS	COST PER SQUARE YARD
------------------------	-------------------------

The first five yards	\$25.00
The next five yards	15.00
The next five yards	14.00
The next ten yards	13.00
For all yards over 25 yards	12.00

(c) Concrete sidewalk. For each square yard or fraction thereof of concrete sidewalk, the current unit price per square yard where established by current year city contract; if there is no current annual city contract, the fee shall be the unit price per square yard of the last annual city contract plus 10% per square yard per year.

(d) Concrete curb and gutter. For each linear foot or fraction thereof of concrete curb and gutter, the current unit price per linear foot where established by current year city contract; if there is no current annual city contract the fee shall be the unit price per linear foot of the last annual city contract plus 10% per linear foot per year.

(e) Brick pavement or sidewalk on sand base. For each square yard or fraction thereof of brick pavement on sand base or brick sidewalk on a sand base, the current unit price per square yard where established by current year city contract, otherwise \$25.00 per square yard with a minimum charge of \$25.00.

(f) Brick pavement or sidewalk on concrete base; brick sidewalk on asphalt base. For each square yard or fraction thereof of brick pavement on a concrete base, brick sidewalk on a concrete base or brick sidewalk on an asphalt base, the current unit price per square yard where established by current year city contract, otherwise \$35.00 per square yard with a minimum charge of \$50.00.

(g) Brick driveway on concrete base. For each square yard or fraction thereof of brick driveway pavement on a concrete base, the current unit price per square yard where established by current year city contract, otherwise \$40.00 per square yard with a minimum charge of \$50.00.

(h) Opening in unsurfaced stabilized or unimproved area. For any opening made in an unsurfaced stabilized or unimproved area, a sum of \$25.00 to cover cost of inspection.

Section 2. That Section 33-82, Division 1, Article V of Chapter 33 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 33-82. Same--Restoration work performed by utility companies.

The fees for restoration work done by public utilities shall be as follows: Actual inspection costs (salaries, test, etc.) plus thirty per cent for administration with a minimum charge of \$25.00 per opening.

Section 3. That Section 33-91, Division 2, Article V of Chapter 33 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 33-91. Fees, surcharges and inspection costs--Payment required.

It shall be the duty and responsibility of any person to pay the applicable fee as set forth in this article and any surcharge and inspection costs prior to the issuance of a permit pursuant to section 33-86.

Notwithstanding the provisions of any other section of this article, the minimum inspection fee for any work covered by this article costing less than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) will be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00); for any work covered by this article costing five hundred dollars or more, the minimum inspection fee will be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Section 4. That Section 33-93, Division 2, Article V of Chapter 33 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 33-93. Same--Surcharge for openings in new streets, etc.

Extra costs (surcharge) for openings in new streets, sidewalks and alleys shall be as follows:

No permit required by section 33-86 shall be issued which would allow an excavation or opening in any paved or improved street or alley or sidewalk the surface of which has been improved within a five-year period preceding the date of permit issuance unless there has first been paid to the city a surcharge which shall be in addition to the usual permit fee. The surcharge shall be equal to fifty per cent of the usual permit fee for an opening if the street or alley or sidewalk has been improved within the preceding five years and seventy-five per cent if such improvement was made within the preceding two years. Utility companies shall also pay the above surcharges based on city restoration costs.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
