

ORDINANCE NO. 1924

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the first sentence of the fifth paragraph of Section 2-86, Article VII, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 2 relates to ADMINISTRATION, which Article VII relates to PURCHASES AND CONTRACTUAL SERVICES, which Section 2-86 relates to PROCEDURE AS TO CONTRACTS; COMPETITIVE BIDS, and which first sentence and fifth paragraph thereof relates to SUBMISSION OF BIDS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the first sentence of the fifth paragraph of Section 2-86, Article VII, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

All bids shall be submitted sealed to the city purchasing agent, and shall be accompanied by a certified check in an amount equal to one-twentieth (5%) of the bid if the bid is \$10,000 or less, unless deemed unnecessary; if the bid is greater than \$10,000, such bids shall be accompanied by a bid bond or certified check in an amount equal to one-twentieth (5%) of the amount of the bid, unless deemed unnecessary.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
