

ORDINANCE NO. 2201

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 34-12, Article II, Chapter 34 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new subsection lettered (d); which Chapter 34 relates to SUBDIVISIONS, which Article II relates to REGULATIONS, which Section 34-12 formerly related to PLATS GENERALLY; SUBDIVISION OF LAND IN DANGER OF FLOOD, ETC.; and which now relates to PLATS GENERALLY; SUBDIVISION OF LAND IN DANGER OF FLOOD, ETC.; SUBDIVISION OF LAND FOUND TO BE CONTAMINATED and which new Subsection (d) relates to SUBDIVISION OF LAND FOUND TO BE CONTAMINATED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 34-12, Article II, Chapter 34 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subsection lettered (d) to read as follows:

(d) If any portion of land shown on a plat is found by the director of transportation and environmental services to be contaminated by a toxic substance and hazardous to the public health, safety and welfare, such area of contamination and the type of substance shall be clearly shown on the plat. The subdivider shall also note on the plat that any use of such land is subject to city Ordinance No. 2145 and Administrative Procedures for Control of Contaminated Land, adopted by council October 26, 1976, as may be amended from time to time.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
