

ORDINANCE NO. 2202

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 7-8, Chapter 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a reference which amends Section 113.0 of the BOCA Basic Building Code by adding thereto a new subsection numbered 113.5.1; which Chapter 7 constitutes the BUILDING CODE OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, which Section 7-8 relates to CHANGE IN BOCA CODE, which Section 113.0 relates to APPLICATION FOR PERMIT and which new Subsection 113.5.1 thereunder relates to PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS--PROVISIONS FOR CONTROL OF CONTAMINATED LAND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 7-8, Chapter 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a reference which amends Section 113.0 of the BOCA Basic Building Code by adding thereto a new Subsection 113.5.1 to read as follows:

113.5.1. Plans and specifications--Provisions for control of contaminated land: In documentation accompanying the application for the permit, provisions for control of contamination of land in accordance with city Ordinance No. 2145 and Administrative Procedures for Control of Contaminated Land, adopted by council October 26, 1976, as may be amended from time to time, shall be described when the site is in an area found by the director of transportation and environmental services to be contaminated by a toxic substance and hazardous to the public health, safety and welfare.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
