

ORDINANCE NO. 2212

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 36-73 of Article XIII of Chapter 36 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 36 relates to TAXATION, which Article XIII thereof relates to REAL ESTATE TAX EXEMPTION FOR ELDERLY AND PERMANENTLY AND TOTALLY DISABLED PERSONS, which Section 36-73 thereof relates to EXEMPTION--PROVIDED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 36-73, Article XIII, Chapter 36 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 36-73. Exemption--Provided.

Commencing January 1, 1972, there is hereby provided an exemption from taxation of real estate in the City of Alexandria owned by, and occupied as the sole dwelling of a person or persons not less than sixty-five years of age or permanently and totally disabled, subject to the restrictions and conditions prescribed by this article and the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
