

ORDINANCE NO. 2303

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 42-1 of Article I by adding thereto a new subsection numbered (12.1) and to amend and reordain subsection (4) of subsection (a) of Section 42-17 of Article III, all of Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article I relates to DEFINITIONS, which Section 42-1 relates to SAME--ENUMERATION, which new subsection (12.1) thereof relates to BINGO HALLS, which Article III relates to USE, AREA, ETC., REGULATIONS GENERALLY, which Section 42-17 relates to C-2 COMMERCIAL ZONE, which subsection (a) thereof relates to USES PERMITTED and which subsection (4) thereof relates to AMUSEMENT ENTERPRISES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 42-1, Article I, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subsection numbered (12.1) to read as follows:

(12.1) Bingo hall. Any building or portion thereof used more frequently than once per calendar month for the playing of any bingo game for which a fee is charged.

Section 2. That subsection (4), subsection (a), Section 42-17, Article III, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(4) Amusement enterprises, including but not limited to theatres, bowling alleys, skating rinks, pool and billiard halls, miniature golf courses, dance halls, amusement arcades, bingo halls and similar uses, only with special use permit, as specified in sections 42-68 to 42-71 of this Code.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 1979.
