

ORDINANCE NO. 2308

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 22-109, Division 1, Article IV of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article IV relates to STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING GENERALLY, which Division 1 relates to SAME--IN GENERAL and which Section 22-109 relates to STOPPING FOR PURPOSE OF SALE, REPAIRS, ETC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 22-109, Division 1, Article IV, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 22-109. Stopping for purpose of sale, repairs, etc.

No person shall park a vehicle upon any street for the purpose of displaying such vehicle for sale, greasing or repairing such vehicle, except repairs necessitated by an emergency.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
