

ORDINANCE NO. 2320

AN ORDINANCE to amend Chapter 18A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding a new section numbered 18A-30; which Chapter 18A relates to HUMAN RIGHTS and which new section numbered 18A-30 thereof relates CITY ATTORNEY--EXCEPTION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Chapter 18A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section numbered 18A-30 to read as follows:

Sec. 18A-30. City Attorney--Exception.

Notwithstanding the provisions of this chapter, the city attorney shall not represent either the commission or the administrator when the city or one of its departments is a respondent. In this event, the commission and the administrator may consult with and refer the matter to a private attorney for appropriate legal action pursuant to this chapter.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
