

ORDINANCE NO. 2416

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the third paragraph of Section 8-1, Article I, Chapter 8 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 8 relates to CHILD CARE, which Article I relates to IN GENERAL, which Section 8-1 relates to DEFINITIONS and which third paragraph relates to DAY NURSERY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the third paragraph of Section 8-1, Article I, Chapter 8 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Day nursery. (a) Any institution operated for the purpose of providing care and maintenance to six (6) or more children under fourteen (14) years of age separated from their parents or guardian during part of the day only, but not for any period between the hours of 7:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M., except a public school or other bona fide educational institution; or (b) any private family home which provides care and maintenance for such children under the same conditions as those set out in clause (a) above, except a home in which such care and maintenance is provided for children related by consanguinity or affinity to the person who maintains such home, and for children as occasional bona fide personal guests, and for no other child or children.

Section 2. That the title of and informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
