

ORDINANCE NO. 2425

AN ORDINANCE to amend the MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN ELEMENT OF THE "ADOPTED CONSOLIDATED MASTER PLAN OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, 1974."

WHEREAS, the city planning commission adopted a resolution on November 5, 1979, recommending that the Major Thoroughfare Plan in the "Adopted Consolidated Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1974," be amended by changing Franklin Street between South Washington Street and South Union Street from a primary collector street to a residential collector street; and

WHEREAS, the city council is of the opinion that said Plan should be amended as aforesaid; therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Major Thoroughfare Plan Element of the "Adopted Consolidated Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1974," which was adopted by ordinance number 1989, be and the same hereby is amended as follows:

A. Delete from the Major Thoroughfare Plan that portion of Franklin Street between South Washington Street and South Union Street as a primary collector street and redesignate same as a residential collector street.

B. Revise the Major Thoroughfare Plan Map to reflect that portion of Franklin Street between South Washington Street and South Union Street as a residential collector street.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
