

ORDINANCE NO. 2514

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 20-73, subsection (B) of Section 20-74 and Section 20-79, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 20 relates to LICENSES, which Article III relates to NONREGULATORY LICENSES, which Section 20-73 relates to PROFESSIONAL OCCUPATIONS AND BUSINESSES, which Section 20-74 relates to PERSONAL SERVICES, which subsection (B) relates to THE BUSINESS OF and which Section 20-79 relates to WHOLESALE MERCHANTS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the list of professional occupations and businesses in Section 20-73, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting the following alphabetically:

Appraiser.
Labor arbitrator.
Medical clinic.
Radiologist.

Section 2. That subsection (B), Section 20-74, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting the following alphabetically:

Furnishing identification services for personal property.

Section 3. That the list of wholesale merchants in Section 20-79, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting the following alphabetically:

Pistols or revolvers.

Section 4. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
