

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-168, Article XIX, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 2 relates to ADMINISTRATION, which Article XIX relates to SOCIAL SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD and which Section 2-168 relates to COMPOSITION; APPOINTMENT; TERM; VACANCY; CHAIRPERSON; COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 2-168, Article XIX, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 2-168. Composition; appointment; term; vacancy; chairperson; compensation of members.

The board shall consist of thirteen (13) members who shall be appointed by the city council; five (5) of whom shall be parents, three (3) of whom shall be clients of the department of social services and five (5) of whom shall be citizens-at-large. In the event that an insufficient number of parents or clients apply for the vacancy to be filled from those groups, the vacancy may be filled by a citizen-at-large. Members shall be appointed for terms of three (3) years each except that any vacancies shall be filled by the council for the unexpired portion of a term. The city manager shall be an ex officio member, without a vote on the board. A chairperson and a vice chairperson shall be chosen by a majority vote of all the members of the board. Members shall serve without compensation but may receive such reimbursement for expenses, subject to appropriation by council.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the

second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting.  
- This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final  
passage.
