

ORDINANCE NO. 2616

AN ORDINANCE to amend Article I, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding a new section numbered 22-15.1, which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article I relates to IN GENERAL and which new section numbered 22-15.1 relates to TRUCK TRAFFIC; PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN STREETS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article I, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section numbered 22-15.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 22-15.1. Truck traffic; prohibited on certain streets.

Motor trucks are prohibited from using South Gordon, South Early and South Floyd Streets, except for the purpose of receiving loads or making deliveries on those or adjacent residential streets.

This ordinance shall be of no force and effect after 12:00 noon on March 22, 1982, unless it is reordained by the city council prior to that time.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
