

ORDINANCE NO. 2623

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (1), subsection (b), Section 42-27, Article V, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article V relates to OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING GENERALLY, which Section 42-27 relates to OFF-STREET PARKING GENERALLY, which subsection (b) relates to SIZES OF PARKING SPACES AND WIDTHS OF AISLES and which subsection (1) relates to AISLES SERVING 90-DEGREE PARKING.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (1), subsection (b), Section 42-27, Article V, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(1) Aisles serving 90-degree parking shall be no less than 22 feet in width, except that where parking on both sides of the aisle is for compact cars, the aisle shall be no less than 20 feet in width unless in special circumstances, the director of transportation and environmental services and the fire marshal shall approve in writing a reduction in the 20-foot width by not more than two (2) feet for an aisle serving not more than 30 parking spaces.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
