

ORDINANCE NO. 2714

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 5-8-152, Article I, Chapter 8, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 5 relates to TRANSPORTATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, which Chapter 8 relates to PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, which Article I relates to VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMITS and which Section 5-8-152 formerly related to PERMITS FOR EXCESSIVE SIZE AND WEIGHT, CONCRETE MIXERS AND CERTAIN COAL-HAULING VEHICLES and now relates to PERMITS FOR EXCESSIVE SIZE AND WEIGHT; CONCRETE MIXERS; CERTAIN COAL-HAULING VEHICLES; CERTAIN REFUSE COLLECTION TRUCKS AND CERTAIN VEHICLES CARRYING CONTAINERIZED FREIGHT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 5-8-152, Article I, Chapter 8, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 5-8-152. Permits for excessive size and weight; concrete mixers; certain coal-hauling vehicles; certain refuse collection trucks and certain vehicles carrying containerized freight.

(a) The director of transportation and environmental services may, in his discretion, upon application in writing and good cause being shown therefor, issue a special permit in writing authorizing the applicant to operate or move a vehicle upon the street of a size and weight exceeding the maximum specified by law. Every permit may designate the route to be traversed and contain any other restrictions or conditions deemed necessary to him. Before a special permit is issued, the applicant shall pay to the city a fee of \$5.00 for a single haul special permit or \$10.00 for an annual haul special permit.

(b) The director of transportation and environmental services, upon application in writing made by the owner or operator of any of the vehicles of the types specified in section 46.1-343 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, shall issue the permits that are provided for in that section.

(c) Every such permit shall be carried in the vehicle to which it refers and shall be open to inspection by any officer. Any person who violates any of the terms or conditions of the special permit shall be punished in accordance with section 10-1-19 of this code.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five

days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
