

ORDINANCE NO. 2818

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 9-8-20, Article B, Chapter 8, Title 9 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 9 relates to LICENSING AND REGULATION, which Chapter 8 relates to JUNK DEALERS, ANTIQUE DEALERS, CANVASSERS, PAWNBROKERS AND DEALERS IN SECONDHAND ARTICLES, PRECIOUS METALS OR GEMS, which Article B relates to JUNK DEALERS, ANTIQUE DEALERS, CANVASSERS, PAWNBROKERS OR DEALERS IN SECONDHAND ARTICLES and which Section 9-8-20 relates to DEALING IN SECONDHAND STEEL, COPPER, ETC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 9-8-20, Article B, Chapter 8, Title 9 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 9-8-20. Dealing in secondhand steel, copper, etc.

Except as provided in the following section, it shall be unlawful for any person to buy, barter, purchase, exchange or accept from any person whomsoever, except plumbers, the owner of buildings from which the material is taken, railroad, industrial, manufacturing and public utility companies or the authorized agents of such companies, lawful owners or junk dealers licensed by any state or political subdivision, any secondhand steel, copper, copper wire, aluminum, aluminum wire, brass, brass bearings or fittings, electric light or gas fixtures, locks or other building hardware, lead or brass water pipes or any part of such fixtures or pipes, wire, cable, lead, solder, iron used by or belonging to a railroad, telephone, telegraph, industrial, manufacturing or public utility company.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
