

ORDINANCE NO. 2906

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsections (1), (3) and (4) of subsection (a), Section 9-12-132, Division 6, Article A, Chapter 12, Title 9 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 9 relates to LICENSING AND REGULATION, which Chapter 12 relates to TAXICABS AND OTHER VEHICLES FOR HIRE, which Article A relates to TAXICABS AND FOR-HIRE VEHICLES, which Division 6 relates to FARES and which Section 9-12-132 relates to AMOUNT OF FARE TO BE CHARGED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsections (1), (3) and (4), subsection (a), Section 9-12-132, Division 6, Article A, Chapter 12, Title 9 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby are amended and reordained to read as follows:

(1) For the first one-tenth (1/10) mile or fraction thereof for one (1) passenger, ninety cents (\$0.90).

(3) For each additional one-tenth (1/10) mile or fraction thereof for one (1) or more passengers, ten cents (\$0.10).

(4) For each one (1) hour of waiting time for one (1) or more passengers \$10.00. Waiting time shall include time consumed while the taxicab is waiting and available to passengers beginning three (3) minutes after the time of arrival at the place to which it has been called, time consumed while the taxicab is stopped or slowed for traffic to a speed of less than seven (7) miles per hour and time consumed for delays or stopovers en route at the direction of a passenger. No time shall be allowed for a premature response to a call. There shall be no charge for mileage when time is being charged for a taxicab that is stopped or slowed for traffic to a speed of less than seven (7) miles per hour. Waiting time shall not include time lost on account of inefficiency of a taxicab.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting.

This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
