

ORDINANCE NO. 3005

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (d), Section 2-2-10, and Section 2-2-11, both of Chapter 2, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 2 relates to GENERAL GOVERNMENT, which Chapter 2 relates to ELECTIONS, which Section 2-2-11 relates to ESTABLISHMENT OF CENTRAL ABSENTEE VOTER ELECTION DISTRICT AND VOTING PLACE, which Section 2-2-10 relates to ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES and which subsection (d) relates to FOURTH WARD.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (d), Section 2-2-10, Chapter 2, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(d) **Fourth Ward.** MacArthur School Election District and voting place; Second Presbyterian Church Election District and voting place; Alfred Street Baptist Church Election District and voting place; Lee Center Election District and voting place. The fourth ward shall be divided into MacArthur School Election District, Second Presbyterian Church Election District, Alfred Street Baptist Church Election District and Lee Center Election District.

(1) The MacArthur School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the centerline of Quaker Lane intersects with a line 50 feet south of the centerline of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane; thence northward along the centerline of Quaker Lane to the centerline of King Street; thence eastward along the centerline of King Street to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Radford Street; thence southward along the centerline of Radford Steet to the centerline of King Street; thence eastward along the centerline of King Street to the line 50 feet south of the centerline of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane; thence westward along such line to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the MacArthur School Election District shall be the MacArthur School, located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Janney's Lane and Yale Drive.

All persons whose residences abut on the south side of Janney's Lane, and whose residences bear a Janney's Lane mailing address, are included within the MacArthur School Election District.

(2) The Second Presbyterian Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where a line 50 feet south of the centerline of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane intersects with the centerline of King Street; thence eastward along the centerline of King Street to the western right-of-way of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence westward along the right-of-way line to the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the centerline of Duke Street; thence westward along the centerline of Duke Street to the centerline of North Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of North Quaker Lane to the line 50 feet south of the centerline of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane; thence eastward along such line to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Second Presbyterian Church Election District shall be the Second Presbyterian Church at 1400 Janney's Lane.

Those persons whose residences abut on the south side of Janney's Lane, but who do not have a Janney's Lane mailing address, are included within the Second Presbyterian Church Election District, even though a portion of their residences may not be within the boundary of that district.

(3) The Alfred Street Baptist Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Wilkes Street and South Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of South Washington Street to the centerline of King Street; thence westward along the centerline of King Street to the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence westward along such right-of-way line to the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence southward along the centerline of South Quaker Lane to Cameron Run; thence eastward with Cameron Run to the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence southward with the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the southern city boundary as established January 1, 1973; thence eastward along such boundary to the centerline of Hooff's Run; thence northward along the centerline of Hooff's Run to a point where it would intersect with a western protraction of the centerline of Wilkes Street; thence eastward in a straight line to the centerline of Wilkes Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Wilkes Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Alfred Street Baptist Church Election District shall be at the Alfred Street Baptist Church, located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Duke Street and South Alfred Street.

(4) The Lee Center Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Wilkes Street and South Washington Street; thence westward along the centerline of Wilkes Street to its end; thence westward along a western protraction of the centerline of Wilkes Street to the centerline of Hooff's Run; thence southward along the centerline of Hooff's Run to the southern city boundary; thence eastward along such boundary to the centerline of South Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of South Washington Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Lee Center Election District shall be at the Lee Center, located at the southwest corner of the intersection of South Patrick Street and Jefferson Street.

Section 2. That Section 2-2-11, Chapter 2, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 2-2-11. Establishment of central absentee voter election district and voting place.

There is hereby established for the City of Alexandria a Central Absentee Voter Election District. The voting place of the Central Absentee Voter Election District shall be the Courthouse located at 520 King Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia. The Central Absentee Voter Election District shall conform in all respects with the provisions of section 24.1-233.1 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
