

ORDINANCE NO. 3022

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (a), Section 11-7-8, Chapter 7, Title 11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 11 relates to HEALTH, ENVIRONMENTAL AND SANITARY REGULATIONS, which Chapter 7 relates to PERSONAL GROOMING ESTABLISHMENTS, which Section 11-7-8 relates to GENERAL SANITARY REQUIREMENTS and which subsection (a) relates to SLEEPING AND COOKING IN PERSONAL GROOMING ESTABLISHMENTS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (a), Section 11-7-8, Chapter 7, Title 11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(a) No portion of any personal grooming establishment shall be used for sleeping purposes nor shall any cooking for public or customer consumption be permitted in a personal grooming establishment.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
