

RESOLUTION NO. 27

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria has benefited greatly from the service of James A. Yancey on the City's Traffic and Parking Board during the period of March 14, 1967 through March 15, 1971; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Yancey has given freely of his time to contribute to the future well being of all Alexandrians; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Yancey served for one year as Vice-Chairman of the Traffic and Parking Board and as Chairman of the Taxicab Task Force with great distinction and contributed directly to the revision of the Taxicab Ordinance and other such ordinances, to the study of numerous traffic problems, and to the development of the City's Highway Safety Commission of which he served as a member; and
