

RESOLUTION NO. 114

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria has requested that traffic signalization and street lighting improvements at and between five intersections along King and Washington Streets be designated as a TOPICS project; and

WHEREAS, this proposed project has been designated as Project 5506-100-101, PE-101, Federal Project T-5506 (12) by the Virginia Department of Highways; and

WHEREAS, this project will aid in relieving traffic congestion and help to improve traffic safety by improving traffic signalization at the intersections of Washington and King Streets; Washington and Cameron Streets; Washington and Prince Streets; King and Columbus Streets and King and Saint Asaph Streets; and

WHEREAS, this project will improve traffic safety by improving street lighting on the 100 blocks of North and South Washington Street and the 700 block of King Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Alexandria that the City Manager be and he hereby is authorized to make payments for fifteen percent (15%) of the cost for preliminary engineering and construction of this project and to execute any necessary contract documents to accomplish said project.
