

RESOLUTION NO. 124

WHEREAS, Philip B. Hall has diligently and with distinction served the City of Alexandria since March of 1946 in various positions of great responsibility, such as the Director of Planning, Acting City Manager and Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, during Mr. Hall's distinguished service with the City, he was instrumental in developing the concept of comprehensive planning in Alexandria, in planning and constructing modern, well-designed thoroughfares in our City, in carrying out enlightened municipal engineering in support of the extensive development that took place in Alexandria in the 1950's and 1960's, and in developing a system to provide emergency flood services in an expeditious and compassionate fashion; and

WHEREAS, "Phil" is going on leave on July 1, 1972, prior to retiring as Director of Alexandria's Public Works Department, effective July 31, 1972; and
