

RESOLUTION NO. 205

RELOCATION ASSISTANCE FOR  
PRESENT OCCUPANTS OF 411-413 DUKE STREET  
DISPLACED BECAUSE OF THE ESTABLISHMENT  
OF INTERIM HOUSE BY FOLD, INCORPORATED

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria, Virginia, has received a grant from the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration through the Virginia Division of Justice and Crime Prevention; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of said grant is to create an emergency residential facility for delinquent or pre-delinquent teenagers in and for the City of Alexandria; and

WHEREAS, said emergency residential facility is to be situated at 411-413 Duke Street in the City of Alexandria; and

WHEREAS, all or a portion of the premises of 411-413 Duke Street is presently occupied by certain persons who will have to be relocated in order to make said premises available for the said emergency residential facility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria does not have personnel versed in carrying out the provisions of the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, but the Virginia Department of Highways does have such personnel available:

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA RESOLVES:

1. That a request on behalf of the City of Alexandria be made to the Virginia Department of Highways to provide adequate trained personnel in order to provide prompt relocation assistance and effect the orderly relocation of the present occupants of 411-413 Duke Street, according to the terms of the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970.
2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to make such request for assistance, to enter into an agreement with the Virginia Department of Highways for the provision of such assistance, and to execute such contracts and documents as may be necessary to procure the assistance.
