

RESOLUTION 223

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF EACH OF THE BOND ORDINANCES FINALLY PASSED ON JUNE 26, 1973, WITH A NOTICE APPENDED THERETO AS TO THE RUNNING OF THE THIRTY DAY PERIOD OF LIMITATION FOR THE COMMENCEMENT OF ANY ACTION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY RESOLVES: :

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to cause the full text of each of the bond ordinances finally passed on June 26, 1973, to be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, not later than June 29, 1973, with a notice appended to each bond ordinance to the effect that the thirty day period of limitation provided for in §7.07 of the Charter of the City of Alexandria within which action questioning the validity of the bond ordinance can be commenced has begun to run, which notice shall be in substantially the following form:

The foregoing bond ordinance was finally passed on June 26, 1973, by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and was published on June 29, 1973.

Any recitals or statements of fact contained in said bond ordinance shall be deemed to be true for the purpose of determining the validity of the bonds, and the City and all other parties interested shall thereafter be estopped from denying them; the ordinance shall be conclusively presumed to have been duly and regularly passed by the City and to comply with the provisions of the Charter of the City and all laws; and the validity of such bond ordinance shall not thereafter be questioned in court action except in an action commenced prior to the expiration of thirty days from the date of publication of such bond ordinance as provided in §7.07 of said Charter.
