

RESOLUTION NO. 303

WHEREAS the City of Alexandria desires to acquire 1,556 square feet of land, more or less, owned by Virgil Brooke Layton and Stanley E. Layton, also known as Stanley Edison Layton shown on Tax Map 214, Block 3, as parcel 1A1.1 and 1A1.2 for Four Mile Run Flood Control Project; and

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 25-248 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, it is necessary to establish the amount believed to be just compensation for said property, in an amount no less than an approved appraisal of the fair market value of such property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

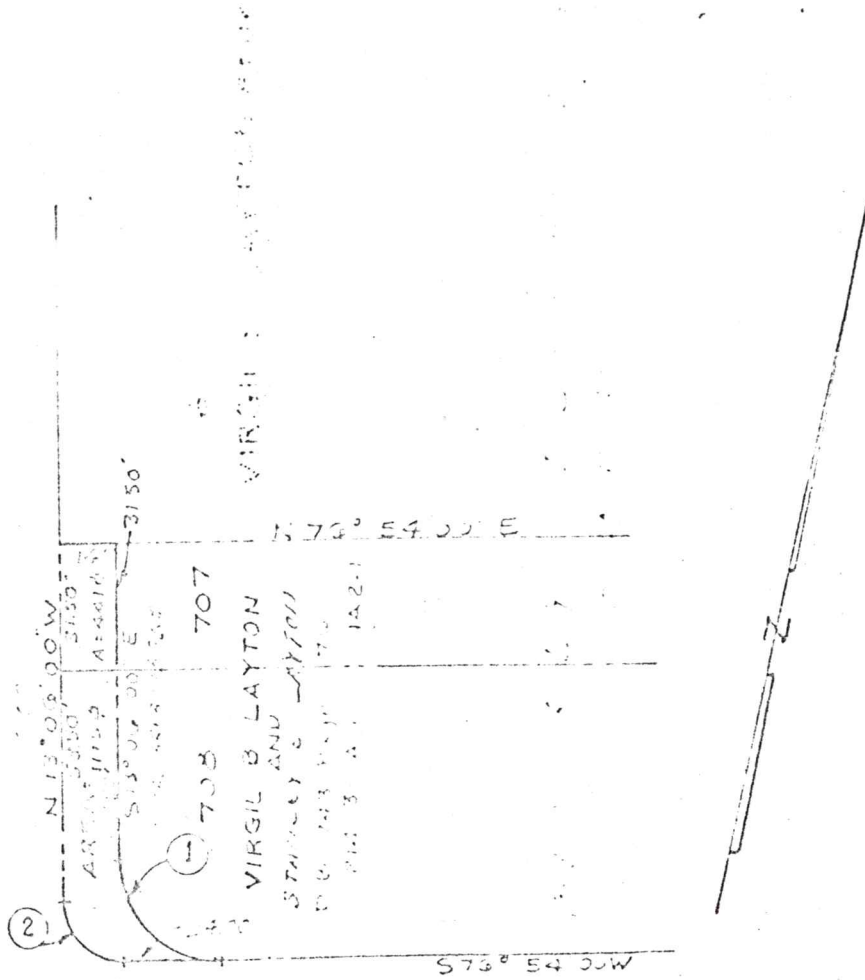
That based on an approved appraisal by a qualified real estate appraiser, the amount of SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS and no/100 (\$7,000.00) is hereby established as the amount believed to be just compensation for the land owned by Virgil Brooke Layton and Stanley E. Layton, also known as Stanley Edison Layton, shown on Tax Map 214, Block 3 as parcels 1A1.1 and 1A1.2. The amount so established is not less than the said approved appraisal.
