

RESOLUTION NO. 315

WHEREAS, the area of Northern Virginia including the City of Alexandria is partially dependent upon bus transportation furnished by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, said bus transportation system has recently been impacted by a series of work stoppages; and

WHEREAS, said work stoppages have resulted in not only eliminating said bus transportation but also in increasing commuter demand for gasoline in the Northern Virginia area; and

WHEREAS, said gasoline demand has increased to a point where it appears existing allocations will be depleted at an abnormal rate; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Virginia is empowered to provide additional gasoline to areas either anticipating or experiencing fuel shortages.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Alexandria respectfully requests the Governor of Virginia to take such actions as are necessary to increase the gasoline supply to the Northern Virginia area.
