

RESOLUTION NO. 318

WHEREAS, the citizens of Alexandria were deeply saddened by the passing of E. Morton Knight on April 29, 1974; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Knight served the Alexandria community for almost 40 years through his employment with the AB&W Transit Company, the last 25 years as assistant administrator in the Public Relations Department; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Knight's civic involvement included 11 years as a member of the City's Traffic and Parking Board; of which five years he served as chairman of the Board; a

WHEREAS, Mr. Knight's activities covered a wide range of community service, including such positions as general chairman of the Campaign Unit of the Community Chest, past president of the Alexandria Lions Club, member of the Alexandria and Arlington Chambers of Commerce and the Washington Board of Trade, and past president and chairman of the President's Cup Regatta; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Knight served his country with distinction during World War II through his service with the American Red Cross.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, wishes to express its sincere and heartfelt sympathy to the family of E. Morton Knight.
