

RESOLUTION NO. 422

WHEREAS, the Fairfax County Water Authority adopted new water rates which were effective on November 1, 1974; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia American Water Company has filed with the State Corporation Commission for new permanent rates to reflect this increased cost; and

WHEREAS, the conservation of water is of utmost importance to the City of Alexandria for its ever increasing population; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria wishes to see a new modern rate structure adopted; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria feels that new customers must pay the cost of providing new water to serve their needs;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Alexandria:

(1) Approves of a rate of 75¢/1000 gallons after the first 20,000 gallons per quarter of consumption which rate shall also cover the cost of reading the meter.

(2) Approves a flat water rate of 60¢/1000 gallons after the first 20,000 gallons per quarter of consumption.

(3) Approves the proposed escalation clause filed by the Virginia American Water Company with the State Corporation Commission.

(4) Approves the new availability charges filed by the Virginia American Water Company with the State Corporation Commission.

(5) Approves the new service connection charges filed by the Virginia American Water Company with the State Corporation Commission.

(6) That these rates should stay in effect until the source of water changes or a new rate from the Fairfax County Water Authority is obtained.

This Resolution shall be filed with the State Corporation Commission as part of the City's testimony at the public hearing on rates scheduled for October 16, 1975.

This Resolution shall take effect on its passage.
