

RESOLUTION NO. 503

WHEREAS, the City Council on October 24, 1974, adopted by motion the "Proposed Master Bikeway Plan" for the city, which plan designated certain areas of the streets, sidewalks and other public property in the city as "bikepaths," for the use and operation of bicycles thereon; and

WHEREAS, the operation of motorized vehicles such as motorcycles and minibikes on those portions of the bikepaths designated by the aforesaid plan that are not part of the streets of the city endangers the health and safety of persons using the bicycle routes for bicycling; and

WHEREAS, Section 22-63 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, prohibits the operation of motorcycles upon any public property in the city, provided such property has been posted with signs indicating that such operation is prohibited;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

That the operation of any motorcycle upon any portion of a designated bikepath in the city be prohibited, and the Director of Traffic is hereby authorized and directed to post upon all designated bikepaths in the city, except such portions as are part of the streets of the city, signs which shall state, in addition to any other language thereon, "motorcycle riding prohibited" or "minibike riding prohibited" or words of similar import.
