

RESOLUTION NO. 513

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Alexandria City Council to provide for comprehensive planning, implementation, and maintenance of the highest quality public educational system our resources will permit;

WHEREAS, in order to maintain and implement such system it is necessary to evaluate both the short term and long term system needs and goals;

WHEREAS, in order to provide for comprehensive planning for said system, said evaluation must be integrated into an analysis of the projected short term and long term financial resources of the City;

WHEREAS, in view of the age and physical condition of certain educational plants in the City, it is the intention of the City Council to complete said evaluation and analysis and implement said plan at the earliest possible date;

The City Council of Alexandria Resolves:

1. That the Alexandria Board of Education is hereby requested to present their projected short term and long range goals and needs, on a priority basis, directed to system facility requirements for the near term of three to five years in the future as well as the long term system requirements in ten to twenty years, said presentation being in terms of what type of educational system the City should be expected to need and could be expected to support;
2. That the requirements at grades 9 and 10 be addressed as a major portion of said presentation, in terms of an overall facilities plan for both the near and long term;
3. That said presentation to City Council occur at a public work session to be held on October 14, 1976, at a mutually agreeable time and place.
